The Town of Hamburg will implement the following rules regarding disqualification from a league contest. If at any time an official or field manager witness conduct against the Code of Conduct the game will be stopped. Officials, field managers, and coaches will meet at mid-field to determine if the misconduct can be resolved without any further action. If terms are unresolved the following policy will be followed.

This policy is in conjunction with the Code of Conduct and League Rules.

**Disqualifications:** A disqualification will result from a player, parent/guardian, or coach's failure to adhere to the Code of Conduct. The disqualified player, parent/guardian, or coach must leave the premises. Failure to do so may result in further action. Disqualification of a player, parent/guardian, or coach may result in a forfeit. This will occur if a disqualified player results in the team having less than enough players to continue the game, there is no assistant coach to replace the disqualified coach, and/or it is deemed unsafe to continue play.

**First Offense:** the disqualified person must leave the premises in a timely manner and is suspended for the next game.

**Repeat Offenses:** the disqualified person must leave the premises in a timely manner and is suspended indefinitely upon review by the Recreation Dept.'s Management Team.

\*\*Repeat offenses may result in permanent suspension from season/league.

**Suspensions:** the suspended person is not allowed on the premises during the suspension.
